

**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN
OF THE CITY OF GLUCKSTADT, MISSISSIPPI
RECOGNIZING GERMANFEST AS A COMMUNITY EVENT CELEBRATING
THE GERMAN HERITAGE AND FOUNDING OF THE COMMUNITY**

WHEREAS, the community of Gluckstadt was founded in 1905 by families of German descent and many descendants of the original families still live in and around the community; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gluckstadt, Mississippi, is a new municipality, its municipal incorporation having taken legal effect on June 6, 2021; and

WHEREAS, Germanfest is a community event held annually on the last Sunday in September, by St. Joseph Catholic Church, in Gluckstadt celebrating the German heritage and founding of the community;

WHEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Gluckstadt, Mississippi, as follows:

1. The City of Gluckstadt wishes to recognize St. Joseph Catholic Church for hosting Germanfest, and for allowing the community to gather together and celebrate the German heritage and the founding of the community.
2. The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Gluckstadt, Mississippi, recognize Germanfest as a community wide event celebrating the heritage and founding of the community, and St. Joseph Catholic Church for hosting the event.
